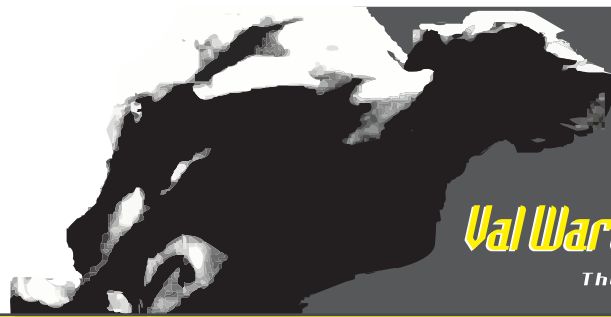

Val Ward Enterprises has been making dog walkers since the 1960's. Starting in Liverpool, NSW, the company is now situated in the NSW Southern Highlands and currently undertakes business in New South Wales, Victoria and Queensland. Val Ward also operates a mail order distribution service for mechanical parts and can perform maintenance of existing dog-walking machines of any type.

Maintenance of existing machines

We are experts in the maintenance of all Val Ward dog walkers and other brands of machines. We are constantly modernising the machines with new belts, changing the old style slat-belt with a new preferred rubberised belt which is quieter, runs faster and requires no maintenance.

The machines are fitted with a heavy duty motor with high-starting torque and has six-speed variable controls, allowing a pacing speed of up to 5 km/h.

A Val Ward dog walking machine is guaranteed to last and with simple maintenance will give you years of service.

All machines are made to order and require a \$500 deposit.

FAQs

What size motor does it have? The Val Ward dog walkers have a one horse power motor, with six variable speeds via a variable speed pulley. This allows you to set the pace of which your dog trains.

How many speeds does it have? The Val Ward dog walkers have six speeds activated by a lever on the side of the machine, just by pulling backward or forward to change the speed.

What sort of a mat does it have? The Val Ward dog walkers have a rubberised mat with guide strips on the side to allow the belt to track correctly. The tension of the mat is adjusted by two bolts at the rear of the machine.

How long does it take to receive the walker upon order? As all Val Ward dog walkers are made to order, depending on our back-log, we usually take approximately two weeks to create a new machine for the customer.

Do you make machines for a special purpose? Yes, in the past we have made machines that:

- Raise up and down to allow the dog to walk in an inclined level
- Computerised versions for programming workouts to make the workout faster and slower and move the machine up and down.
- We can also make a four dog walking machine.

Do you have a warranty for your machines? We have a 12 month warranty on the machines we supply.

Services
